When replacing the drained oil, be careful not to overfill. Many experts recommend under-filling at first and waiting about ten minutes before adding more, so the oil has time to settle and you can accurately judge how much more is needed. It is also recommended that the oil levels be regularly checked, so a top-off can be done if necessary.

Check Spark Plugs

The spark plugs in a vehicle, when in good condition appear dark gray in color and have a sooty-like feel. If the plugs become gunky or develop a greasy build-up, it can be a sign of an oil leak.

Check the Battery

A common problem that people face is a dead car battery. While it might not affect the overall state of your luxury vehicle, it can be devastating to find yourself stranded because your car wonâ€™t start. Check your battery regularly.
