Custom Packaging

Custom packaging, on the other hand, is designed specifically for one product for optimum protection. Packaging supplies like this are great for products that can easily break or deform when mishandled because they are usually made to follow the contour of the product, protecting them from harm. For example, when you buy a new computer, it is encased in foam that fits around it perfectly.
