A lot of people immediately assume that once an accident occurs and they sustain damage that they must sue the other party with immediate effect. This is not the case as depending on the circumstances they too can be held accountable due to negligence. These claims more often than not can be settled without having to go to court, saving everyone a lot of time and money.

If you are an individual that is a victim in an accident and you are not at fault then you have the right to get compensation from the other party. There are certain steps that you must take to solidify the claim. As soon as the accident occur one must contact the local authorities, file a report, take pictures of the injuries and the area that the accident occurred in, also get accounts from any witnesses that may have been present. The more proof you have the stronger the case will be. Also contract the services of an Orange County accident attorney.

As soon as enough evidence is in hand then you can begin the process to claim compensation. Bear in mind that suing is not the only option as many cases need not go to court and can easily be sorted out with the person at fault or their insurance company. An Orange County injury lawyer can give you all the guidance necessary on what the best options are.

The Orange County personal injury attorney will also have access to medical experts to make the case stronger. They have the responsibility to gather all the doctors's reports, medical bills and records, get all the witness accounts and any other details related to the claim. They will then file the suit once all that information is in place. The person at fault will have a particular time period to respond when they can opt to settle via negotiation. After this period has passed and no response is received then the case will go on to court.

If you do not have an Orange County injury lawyer representing you, you may be waiting for a number of months just to get the hearing started, the skilled attorney is able to give you the advice you need and suggest the best course of action. Once the hearing convenes the judge will determine whether or not the claimant is to get compensation and how much based on the facts presented.

A lot has to be considered before filing an injury claim. Once the accident occurs contact an Orange County injury lawyer so that you can be aware of all the options available to you if it is determined that you are not liable in any way.
