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When you put company retreats, wedding receptions, and ballrooms in one box, what do you get? The answer, quite simply, is a huge space that can accommodate hundreds of guests for a variety of activities. This is because parties in general have one thing alike: a substantial number of attendees as well as the celebrant and event staff. One is fine, two is a party, and three is a crowd, but four or more attendees may call for an event center.

As the coordinator of a particular event, you would not want any associate of yours to be excluded from all the fun. Immediately, you ask yourself where to accommodate hundreds of guests in one place at any given time. You want a huge floor area for the visitors to move around, in addition to a place for the buffet table, stage, tables and chairs, and other party favors. When it comes to party planning, floor space means everything.

The following cases to be discussed later call for a big area not only because of the huge number of guests, but also because they have to move. Give anyone several square feet of elbow room, say no more than 12 square feet, and that will be enough. Don't forget to check your guest list frequently so you can consider the space to be booked with the number of attendees in mind. The most crucial thing is that they do not become unruly, thus increasing the chances of somebody getting injured.

Ballroom. If your guests are going to dance the night away, the space should be big enough to allot adequate room for a ballroom floor. Also, since the type of ballroom Denver CO partygoers use typically involves dancing as a couple, they need elbow room even more. Remember that couples need a minimum of nine square feet, and not everybody will always be dancing simultaneously. In this case, you do not have to take account of the total dance floor area for the complete number of guests.

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
