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If you stop and think for a moment that this really should not be a surprise if you are going for river rafting in Nepal’s tranquil rivers. Sooner or later the snow at least the lower parts of the great mountain of Nepal have to melt and when it does, you have to spend some. Eons of melt water have carved deep canyons and valleys.

Drawing a mountainous terrain of Nepal, there are three main river systems-the Koshi, Gandaki and Karnali. These three rivers mostly arise from the upper glaciers - melting of glaciers and high altitude lakes. With a raft undulating sweep through deep valleys, strong and clear skies throughout, river rafting in Nepal can be the highlight of any trip to Nepal.

One of the new rivers for rafting in Nepal is the Marshyangdi. Considered one of the best whitewater rafting rivers in the world, Marshyangdi is not for the inexperienced or faint of heart. With a top-level guidance and knowledge of what to expect, the Marshyangdi you to a new level of experience rafting. And as you twist and turn through the rapids that could even detect the peaks of Annapurna Manasalu or distance covered by luxury train in India.

There is little information available about the Marshyangdi, except that it is fast and furious. Because only recently those tourism business operators may purchase the appropriate permissions to access the drop and collection points situated around the local villages, many of the rapids are not yet classified or named. After a rafting trip one day you might feel like writing down descriptions of the rapids reminded that you have experienced during your Nepal travel.

Another wild river's growing popularity is the Trishuli. Most tour companies and passenger-days Baireni put on rafts, a city full of Hindu temples famous for detailed carved wooden windows and doors. At this point, the moments of Calm River moves slowly, and plunges into the drain from time to time. With quick easy to classify as high as IV and V, is better than listening to the guide or you'll be swimming for the next landfall.

Trishuli River has a wider selection of flora and fauna of the Marshyangdi. Here the landscape is pastoral, with fields and orchards lining the slopes and terraces sloping hills. More likely is that you can glimpse the wildlife and birds here as the coast between the rapid. After this bit of touring comfort, the river will take you through gorges and rapids defies death after passing the city of Charaundi. If you want to ride the biggest fast, visit this river after the summer monsoon season, which promises faster it goes, the more pronounced low, and the swirling arms to keep turning. Although well visited and known regular beams, the range promises Trishuli River at least as rafting and more opportunities to take pictures of a river with rapids rated higher thus making your Nepal tour a memorable one.

You could spend a year of rafting in Nepal, but with a little planning you can find just the river in Nepal to suit your sense of adventure and your time frame.

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
