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In the case of printers, may it be inkjet or laser; printing is accomplished using a cartridge. For a Pitney Bowes DM500 mailing system, ink consumption is monitored by an optical sensor that relays a signal to the IntelliLink Control System when the supply of the cartridge is used up. The ink control mechanism functions automatically and renders precise interpretations about ink consumption levels, so users never experience an empty supply of ink while printing.

Taking out Ink Cartridge from the Mailing System

When ink cartridge supply is consumed, the necessity to substitute the Pitney Bowes ink cartridge goes essential. Hereunder are some procedures to direct the user in discharging the cartridge from the digital mailing system.

Most importantly, the topmost platform must be plucked from the machine. This is where envelopes of the postage machine are generally weighed in.

When the platform is out, open the front flap. A cautionary message on the purpose to substitute cartridges will come out of the main screen. Press Yes.

Thenceforth, the printer will relocate the ink cartridge into a location where it can be easily extracted. The green guard cover will also get in position, fastening the emptied cartridge.

Push the green guard and the cover will open to expose the drained ink cartridge. Press the lock ridges on the top and bottom of the cartridge. When a definite snap is heard, the old cartridge has been ejected from the unit. Draw out the drained cartridge and put aside.

Setting up the Compatible Pitney Bowes Ink Cartridge

Cartridge replacement for Pitney Bowes digital mailing systems is not limited to the supplies that OEM Pitney Bowes provides. The compatible ink cartridges can be loaded up to the postage machine as well. The following are the steps on how to load the Pitney Bowes 621-1 compatible cartridge to the printer.

Take hold of the new cartridge and take out the tape that is attached to its lower portion. The tape acts as a sealer that forbids leakages while the cartridge is in transport. Hence, ink will not stream from the cartridge if the tape is not taken away and printing will not be conceivable.

Slip in the new Pitney Bowes cartridge into the slot. Pause for the ridges to click, signaling that the cartridge is in place and fastened tightly.

Shut the cover of the machine, reinstall the weighing platform, and check that all connections are plugged to each other firmly. When the cartridge is in position, the postage machine will finish the installment of the brand new cartridge.

Execute trial prints to evaluate the caliber of the text and pictures.

The Pitney Bowes 621-1 OEM cartridge for the PB 500 postage machine series tolls for over \$113 while a compatible inkjet cartridge is accessible for only \$48. This renders the user savings of

approximately 60%.

At last, users are handily advised of the ink level uptake in PB postage machines, causing ease in the whole replacement process. Therefore, users are awarded with a cost-efficient alternative in the Pitney Bowes 621-1 compatible ink cartridges .

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
