You must make it clear beforehand that the interstate movers you are contacting is by himself a mover or a broker and if he is only a broker then know about who will be actually moving the things. You should have complete information about both of them. When the interstate movers load the things, try to get the weight of the truck so that you will know the exact weight of the things you are moving. You must make sure that you are able to understand all the terms and conditions of the agreement provided by the interstate movers. You must have somebody to oversee the loading and unloading of things at both the places.

If you don't understand a particular point in the document, do not sign it. You should carry all the valuable things with you only and you should not delay in making claim for a damage or loss as the delay would absolve the interstate movers of their fault.

By following all these things you can move your house smartly and without any stress. And get ready for a new home experience.
