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If you require cesspool pumping, you shouldnâ€™t put it off. There are many well founded reasons to not avoid cesspool pumping. As a good rule of thumb, you should have your septic system inspected once per year, and pumping conducted at least once per year or so. What follows are a few primary reasons to never backburner cesspool pumping.

Harmful Viruses & Bacteria

One of the key reasons to get cesspool pumping is to control the growth of harmful bacteria and viruses. Over time, the waste and the stagnant water is the ideal breeding ground for dangerous bacterium and viruses. If left unchecked, these viruses and bacterium can cause many health problems. The units are designed to control them, but not forever. Even a half full septic tank should be drained at least once every 12-18 months for health reasons.

City Code

All regions in the US will have varying city code regarding mandated cesspool pumping procedures for homeowners and tenants. Make sure to look up the city code in your region to find out what it may be. From time to time, inspectors will stop by to look at your cesspool. If you are not adhering to city code, you could be issued a citation for failure to conduct appropriate cesspool pumping.

Damage to Septic System

Your septic system is designed to be formidable but not impervious. Thatâ€™s why cesspool pumping needs to be conducted once in a while. The best way to know when you should have yours drained and pumped is to contact a services provider in your area and have your make and model inspected.

Backed Up Drainage

The last thing that you ever want to have is backed up drainage when you fail to do your cesspool pumping. Now we canâ€™t all be septic tank gurus here, and thatâ€™s okay (thatâ€™s what the pros are for). However, we can be avid about taking care of our septic systems. Thatâ€™s why the pros suggest that you get a complete septic tank inspection at least once every couple of years. If you want to play it safe, have your tank inspected one time per year, and have cesspool pumping conducted at least once per year. Your services provider will be able to advise you on the best cesspool pumping schedule and maintenance schedule for your septic systems. By being proactive, your septic system can last you a lifetime.
