More than just a mini visual spectacle, the satisfaction you feel is probably due to the fact that at the back of your mind, you know the drains and pipes are doing just fine. However, when the whirlpool dies only to be replaced by rising bubbles, then it's an entirely different story.

Whenever you see something like that, you know that something below is blocking your drain. For residents of Vancouver, this isn't an uncommon event. Many homes in Vancouver have old drainage systems that are vulnerable to collapse. Some pipes, by virtue of age and ground pressure, are now probably deformed, making their warped segments choke points.

Of course, some problems can be fixed by a little do-it-yourself cleaning. Nevertheless, if the problem is more serious and extensive, then it's probably wise to call in the professionals. Regardless of the kind of intervention, knowing the common culprits of blocked drains can help you make a better decision:

Trees and leaves. Autumn is the season wherein the most amount of leaves fall to the ground. In time, the leaves can accumulate in the drains and cause blockage. A more serious problem than impacted leaves are tree roots that grow close to the pipes, as they can crack into the pipelines themselves, causing blockage.

Grease and fat. While not as voluminous as leaves, they can still be a major headache. The reason is due to grease's adhesive properties. The leftovers from food and cooking oil end up as greases that stick to the inside of the pipes. Grease and fat tend to build up to a point wherein water is no longer able to pass through the pipes. Thus, when performing drain cleaning Vancouver home contractors suggest using strong caustic solvents to dissolve the grease.

Hair buildup. Your hair may not look significant enough to cause a blocked drainage, but over time, they can be quite a problem. If you haven't cleaned your bathroom drainage for years, chances are, a thick tangle of hair is clinging inside pipe walls and drains. Thus, in cleaning drainage Vancouver homeowners use devices to catch the hair before it goes into the pipes.

Leaves, grease and hair—these are just some of the most common problems in drainage Vancouver homes face every day. While they're rarely seen, drains are no less important, as they make sure the water you use flows freely in the right direction.
