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A cell phone today is a prerequisite for a person to be called civilized. Without a mobile phone, it is not hard but impossible to survive in today's world. Be it a student going to the college, a person working in a bank, a housewife tending to the kids at home or a grandparent, everyone needs a cell phone at all times. However, at the same time, we are very well aware of the fact that the prices of even the daily needs are shooting skywards and affording a cell phone might not be very easy for everyone. All said and done, a mobile phone, no matter how important, is just another bill that we need to pay at the end of every month.

Understanding the fact that a mobile phone is indispensable today, the federal government has now started a free cellular phone service. This service is guided by the Lifeline, which is federal program. Under this service, anyone who applies is eligible to receive a free cell phone along with certain basic facilities like making long distance and local calls, receiving and sending text messages, accessing 911, directory assistance and voicemail. The person receives fixed number of minutes every month. This may vary from 69 minutes to 200 minutes per month, depending on the state of residence. However, anyone can buy additional minutes at discounted prices.

This service is available in all the states but the terms and conditions and the qualifying criteria for each state is different. For the states of Louisiana, Arkansas, Illinois, Oklahoma, Maryland, Missouri, Pennsylvania, Kansas, Washington, Rhode Island, Nevada, Iowa, Texas and West Virginia, the qualifying criteria is the same. The applicants must be participating in any of the government assistance programs like Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly Food Stamps), Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), Medicaid, National School Lunch Program's Free Lunch Program, Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF).

A person is eligible to apply even if the household income is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. This free government assisted cell phone usually does not cost anything. However, there are a few costs for certain states. As the residents of Oklahoma have to pay \$1 per month for the 1000-minute plan and in Texas, the applicant has to pay a \$30 activation fee.

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
