It's also integral that your pet crab has an abundance of carotene and antioxidants. These will help guarantee that your crab maintains a healthy orangeish-red color. If you note that that your hermit crab has molted and does not seem to be acquiring his color back, he may have a deficiency. You can give your crab things like corn, carrots, or even pesticide free marigold petals to help them get these vital vitamins and minerals.

Aside from just making sure your crab gets the best amount of vitamins, it's also very important that you feed them the types of foods that they would consume in the wild. Hermit crabs are scavengers, which should tell you they eat whatever they can discover laying around in their tide pool, on the seashore, or the edges of the tree line. This can incorporate things like dead fish, nuts, seeds, coconuts, grass, meat, fruit and greens. A great rule of thumb for feeding your hermit crab is to only feed it healthy things that you mum would have fed you, or the doctor would tell you to eat more of.

Hermit crabs love crunchy food so make sure that you are getting them fresh fruits and vegetables, not old food that has dried out or canned food.
