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While buying a flagpole one has to evaluate several aspects like price, length, compatibility and positioning. In other words, shopping for a suitable flagpole is not an easy task, unless you have enough experience in buying them.

There are different types of flagpoles available in the market and they are designed to suit multiple purposes. Basically when you step into a shop looking for a good flagpole, the first question your salesman might ask would be whether you want a ground flagpole or a wall mount pole.

Ground poles come within variable sizes ranging from 10 to 100 feet in height. Ground flagpoles accompany a concrete support or stand that holds the pole in position. This support or stand is portable and you can easily move your flag's location to anywhere you need. On the other hand, if you want the flag to be positioned at a single spot permanently then instead of using a movable support, you can install the pole directly into the ground by drilling a hole.

While buying a flagpole, you should ensure that it is sturdy and durable. Flagpoles are meant to be erected in the outdoors and they are intensely subjected to natural forces like wind, rain and sunlight. Durable flagpole an aluminum flagpole would be a perfect choice. Aluminum flagpoles are popular as they are strong and corrosion resistant. Aluminum flagpoles are flexible and though they bend with heavy breeze they are rarely subjected to any serious damage. Aluminum and other metal flagpole come with different types of colorful enamel finishing. Black, white and bronze finishes are commonly used.

While buying a flagpole you should look for proper construction. If your flagpole is tall, then it must also be proportionally thick. Tall poles that are comparatively thinner get easily damaged over time. The quality of the flagpole you need depends on the frequency of its use. If you have to use it continuously for a long time, then definitely you should opt for a valuable and high quality flagpole, certified for its sturdy construction and reliability. Heavy poles that are beyond 50 feet in height, requires periodic checking for any possible damage. At many places flagpoles break down during rainstorms and strong winds causing damage to people and vehicles. In order to avoid such mishaps, one has to ensure that the flagpole is intact and is also installed securely on the ground.

Apart from aluminum, fiberglass flagpoles are nowadays in high demand. They are also sturdy like aluminum but they have an additional advantage of being resistant to lightening. Aluminum is an electric conductor and lightening can strike it quite easily. For this reason fiberglass flagpole is often preferred over aluminum flagpole although the former is a bit more expensive. However, the only disadvantage of a fiberglass flagpole is that their external coating withers off in few years unless it is painted using a high quality weatherproof coating. Apart from the right material, you should also find the right type of flagpole that can be easily installed, used and maintained.
