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Part 1. Mac MTS to iMovie Converter

MTS to iMovie Converter is a professional program for Mac users to convert MTS files from Canon, Sony, Panasonic, JVC and Sanyo etc camcorders to iMovie supported formats: MP4, DV, MPEG-2, HDV, MOV etc, then import converted MTS video to iMovie`08, MTS movie to iMovie`09, MTS files to iMovie`11 for further editing on Mac.

Additional, MTS to iMovie converter Mac has advanced editing function. It allows us to edit AVCHD.MTS files: Clip(set start and end), Crop(set aspect ratio 16:9/4:3), Merge(join several MTS files into one), Apply effect(adjust brightness, contrast, and saturation etc), set output parameter(adjust resolution, Frame Rate, Encoder and Bitrate), Snapshot, Rotate etc on Mac os x.

In fact, MTS to iMovie software also has other powerful converting function:

Input files: AVCHD, M2TS, MTS, TS, TD, TP, TRP, MOD, TOD, WMV, 3GP, 3G2, MOV, MPEG-1/2/4, FLV/F4V, AVI(DivX/Xvid), RMVB/RM, DV, MPG, MP4, MKV etc.

Output video: MOV, WMV, 3GP, 3G2, MPG, FLV, AVI(Xvid/DivX), RMVB/RM, DV, MPEG-1/2/4, MKV, M4V, SWF, ASF etc.

Output software: iMovie, Final Cut Express/Pro, Premiere Pro, QuickTime, iTunes etc.

Portable devices: PSP, iPad, iPod, iPhone, Gphone, BlackBerry, Apple tv, Mobile Phone etc.

Output audio: MKA, MP3, WAV, M4A, AAC, AC3, AIFF, AMR, FLAC, WMA, MP2

Output image: BMP, JPEG, JPG, PNG

Part 2. Step by step on importing and converting MTS Files to iMovie

Step 1. Download <http://www.mtsconverters.com/mts-to-imovie/>

Free download "iOrgsoft MTS to iMovie converter for Mac", install and run it.

Step 2. Load MTS files and set output formats

Click "Add Files" to add MTS files, batch convert supports.

Then, from the expanded menu, choose output formats for your files and select a folder to save your ripe MTS, you can set video resolution etc by click "Setting".

Step 3. Convert

One simple click on "Convert button", you can finish your conversion quickly with MTS to iMovie converter for Mac, then import MTS into iMovie for further editing on Mac.

Optional step: Import MTS to iMovie/Edit your MTS files using MTS to iMovie software by click "Clip", "Edit" etc, just try by yourself.

Part 3. Why we need to convert MTS?

MTS and M2TS are file extensions for the same AVCHD and both support 720p and 1080i HD video formats.

Tips:

iMovie is a proprietary video editing software application which allows Mac users to edit their own home movies. Users can edit the video clips, add titles, and add music. Effects include basic color correction and video enhancement tools, and transitions.

AVCHD.MTS files always can not be natively supported by various software or device. iMovie'09 says can accept MTS clips, but only when they are running on an Intel-chip based Mac. A PPC Mac won't work.
