The same was termed as Windows Security Center in Vista and XP.

ReadyBoost

This gives an edge to your system in terms of performance, and you should really appreciate Microsoft for that. It transfers the hard-disk cache to external USB drive in order to accelerate the read operations for better PC performance. But the device and the running program should match the system compatibility.

Check for viruses and spyware
